

From the Pastor's Desk:

Dear Parishioners,

Do you know anyone with Celiac Disease? Chances are now a days you do. I have been hearing more and more about this difficulty in many people's lives and so has the Church. Celiac disease is a disorder that causes problems in your intestines when you eat gluten, which is in wheat, rye, barley and oats. It is a lifetime disease that effects both children and adults. I don't know why I haven't thought to do something sooner and I'm sorry to all those who have been suffering silently while trying to go to Holy Communion. We have purchased some specially made hosts that are acceptable to most everyone who has Celiac Disease. How I propose we use them is quite simple. If you would like to receive these special hosts please see the sacristan (the young man or woman who sets up for Mass) before Mass begins and they will put out a special container with the hosts on the altar. Then please make sure to go to the priest Presider for Holy Communion. It will be helpful if you are as close as possible to the beginning of the Communion line.

While I was thinking about how to better serve our brothers and sisters who can't eat gluten I thought about the possibility of giving the faithful the possibility of receiving from the chalice. Vatican II was adamant that the fullest expression of the "sacred meal" dimension of the Eucharist was to offer both the host and the chalice to the people. Here at St. Paul's logistics of our Church layout make it impossible to easily offer the Precious Blood to everyone, however that does not mean we cannot offer it to anyone. The plan is to add two Eucharist Ministers to the 5 pm and 9:30 am Masses who would give the Precious Blood of Christ to the faithful. They would be located in the main Church, but anyone from the skyboxes would be able to come down and receive if they so choose. We would also like to have a large group training for our Eucharistic Ministers sometime at the end of August to train them in administering the chalice. We might experiment with the chalice this summer but look for an opportunity to receive from the cup on a regular basis in September.

Vatican II also reaffirmed that in one piece of the host or in one sip of the consecrated wine the fullness of the Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity of Jesus Christ is received.

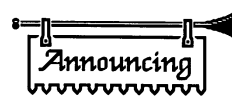
