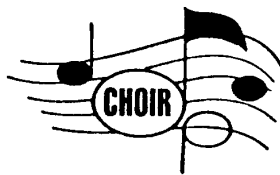

Bishops Welcome Ruling Against Embryonic Stem Cell Funding: Cardinal Daniel DiNardo of chairman of the USCCB Committee on Pro-Life Activities, welcomed the federal court injunction against the Obama administration's funding of human embryonic stem cell research, calling the ruling a "victory for common sense and sound medical ethics." He said this ruling also indicates the bishops' reading of the Dickey amendment, the amendment approved by Congress since 1996, which prevents federal funding of research in which human embryos are harmed or destroyed.
