- ◆ Recite the Creed and one Our Father.
- ◆ Pray for the Pope's Intentions (recommended: Our Father, Hail Mary, and Glory Be, or any prayer for Pope Benedict and his intentions).
- ◆ Taking part in a Mass, prayer service, or a special prayer honoring St. Paul. This would include reading a prayer in honor of St. Paul. There are some available. All of this while visiting our wonderful Church of St. Paul's, Ellicott City.
